## 1- Provide a PowerPoint:

Based on your expertise and knowledge, the Education Committee first requests a PowerPoint presentation in one of the below subject areas:

Anesthesia

Biomechanics Osseous and Soft Tissue Neoplasms

Common Pediatric Deformities Peripheral Vascular Disease

Emergency Medicine Pharmacology

Endocrine Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation

Foot Orthoses and Pedorthics Podiatric Dermatology

General Medicine Public Health – Biostatistics/Epidemiology

General Pediatrics Rheumatology Imaging/Radiology Sports Medicine

Infectious Diseases Surgical Criteria and Complications
Laboratory Medicine Trauma to the Foot and Ankle

Neurology Wound Care

## **Suggestions for PowerPoint lecture development:**

Include Etiology, Epidemiology, Natural History, Risk Factors, Physical Exam, Ancillary Tests (Labs, Radiographs, MRI/CT/Ultrasound/Vascular Tests), Differential Diagnoses, Treatment, Complications, Reference page. Note that lecture should be evidence-based.

## 2- Convert to MP4:

After reviewing your submitted lecture (should be minimum 30 minutes in length), the Education Committee will request that you to convert the lecture to MP4 format with voiceover and send the MP4 file to our office (via <a href="mailto:info@acpmed.org">info@acpmed.org</a>).
